TITLE: Board of Ethics - Appointments

ACTION: Motion to approve the appointment of Juan Vigil representing District 1 and Francis J. Duffy Jr. representing District 2 to the Bernalillo County Ethics Board.

SUMMARY:

The Board of Ethics is charged with enforcing the provisions of the Code of Ethics and the Campaign Reporting Act. Each Commissioner has one position on the Board of Ethics.

Commissioner Armijo requests the appointment of Juan R. Vigil to represent Commission District 1. Mr. Vigil, former Manager and Chief Executive Officer of Bernalillo County, possesses an extensive background in management and administration for national, state and local government. He has served as a White House Fellow, Executive Assistant at the United States Department of Labor, as Director for the City of Albuquerque's Department of Human Services, the Human Rights Department, the University of New Mexico's New Careers Program and the Mental Health Center. He also served as Cabinet Secretary for the State of New Mexico Human Services Department. Mr. Vigil will serve his first 3-year term ending August 26, 2011.

Commissioner Cordova requests the appointment of Francis J. Duffy to represent Commission District 2. Dr. Duffy in 1977 received his degree from Southern California college of Optometry specializing in contact lenses and sports vision. He opened and operated a private practice from November 1977 through July 2000. He then joined the staff at New Mexico Eye Clinic from July through present as an Optometrist. He also currently works as a contract Optometrist for the Alamo Navajo Health Center. Mr. Duffy's will serve his first 3-year term ending August 26, 2011.
