

**AMENDMENTS TO BERNALILLO COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TIDD ORDINANCE, 2007**

Amendment 1, Section 1, subparagraph B, page 2, line 8 is amended by adding the following after “facilities”, public safety facilities, fire protection and police facilities, and workforce housing

Amendment 2, Section 2, subparagraph C, page 2, line 10 is amended by adding subsection number (1) before the title “Compliance with County Policy” . . .

Amendment 3, Section 2, subparagraph C, page 2, line 19 is amended by adding after “applicant’s/landowner’s property’s.” a subsection number (2) The gross receipts tax increment of a TIDD shall not include gross receipts taxes derived from retail sales.

Amendment 4, Section 2, subparagraph A, subsection (3), page 7, line 5 is amended by adding the following after “housing,” public safety facilities, fire protection and police facilities, . . .

Amendment 5, Section 3, subparagraph F, page 11, line 12 is amended by adding after subsection “(11) The amount, type . . .” a subsection number (12) The location and description of public safety facilities and fire protection and police facilities

Amendment 6, Section 3, subparagraph F, page 11, line 12 is amended by adding before subparagraph “(G) Financial Feasibility Study” a subsection number (13) The location and description of local retail facilities. The applicant shall be required to dedicate a minimum of ten percent (10%) of retail development within the TIDD for rental or lease to local retail businesses. Local retail businesses are retail enterprises not affiliated with international, national, or regional enterprises.

Amendment No. 1

Section 1. subsection (C) page 2, line 10 after (C) add (1) after line 19, add (2) the amount of property taxes as determined for the Base Year shall be adjusted each year thereafter for the annual increase in the Consumer Price Index (the “CPI”) or such other inflation index commonly used if the CPI is no longer used.
