1. Accept Sub-Grant Agreement #2006-GR-0064-BERNALILLO EX for the allocation of \$130,000.00 from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security acting through the State of New Mexico Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management.
2. Approve Financial Resolution FR -**2008** budgeting the grant amount of \$130,000.00.

### **SUMMARY:**

The New Mexico Department of Homeland Security and Emergency Management under the Federal Department of Homeland Security has awarded Bernalillo County a total allocation in the amount of \$130,000 for training and exercises.

The Bernalillo County Office of Emergency Management agrees to expend New Mexico Department of Homeland Security training and exercise grant funds in accordance with terms and conditions described in the attached sub-grant agreement and the Homeland Security Exercise and Evaluation Program.

It is the Bernalillo County Office of Emergency Management's responsibility to coordinate training and exercise among its various departments to meet the criteria as follows:

- Assess current All-Hazards Plan for completeness and relevance
- Assess the current level of training and All-Hazards Plan knowledge for all response agencies within the county.
- Conduct necessary training
- Train on newly received response equipment
- Conduct exercise using relevant equipment, training, and plans
