COMMISSIONER ALAN B. ARMIJO ELECTED CHAIR

County Commissioner Alan B. Armijo was elected to serve as Chair of the Commission for 2005 at last night's Administrative Meeting.

Commissioner Armijo is currently serving his first term representing District 1. He joined the Board of Commissioners after serving as an Albuquerque City Councilman for twelve years. He is currently the Governmental Liaison for APS where he has over twenty-five years of experience as a teacher and coach. He is an advocate for education, youth programs, smart planning for growth and operating a fiscally responsible government.

Representing the needs of his constituents, he serves on the following boards and committees: Albuquerque / Bernalillo County Government Commission (ABCGC)/Chair, Albuquerque Bernalillo County Water Utility Authority/Chair, Board of Finance, Legislative Committee, Mid-Region Council of Governments and the Metropolitan Transportation Board.

Commissioner Tim Cummins was elected to serve as Vice-Chair of the Commission. He is serving his second term representing District 4 and was an Albuquerque City Councilor for four years. He has been a commercial real estate broker for 27 years and owns and manages Cummins Real Estate. He has served as one of the seven original trustees for the Endowment Foundation for All Faiths and as a member on the Board of Governors for Goodwill Industries. He is a member of various community organizations and is currently on the YMCA Board. He is currently serving on the Albuquerque / Bernalillo County Government Commission (ABCGC), the Metropolitan Detention Center Operation Subcommittee, Albuquerque Economic Development, the Board of Finance, Legislative Committee and the Metropolitan Transportation Board.
