1. CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 12:30 pm by Chair Sarate.

2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA

4. **NEW BUSINESS**

a. DFA Program Manager for Bernalillo County – Michael Baldwin

Michael Baldwin, from the state of New Mexico, local government division, who is the project manager for Bernalillo County, was the guest speaker. He was there at the request of the DWIPC, who wanted more clarification of their role with Bernalillo County DSAP.

Michael went over the guidelines, statutes, and goals of the DWI, and the role of what DWIPC should do. He informed them that basically DWIPC role is that of advisory and to make recommendations to the County Commission on what DWI should and could do to reduce the incidents of DWI. Michael also advised the DWIPC that the components that provide services to Bernalillo County through DSAP are as follows:

- Alternative sentencing
- Prevention, enforcement
- Treatment,
- Compliance monitoring
- Coordination, planning, and evaluation.

Michael presented to the DWIPC that prevention was the biggest component service that we provide to the community.

Kevin Hartnett questioned the requirements of for each component, and what feedback was received to the state. He also questioned the current program status and then made a suggestion of what thinking was utilized to progress in forward manner as to what can be done for possible added services. He wanted to know what is effective and what is not, and if any changes are recommended how would they be implemented.

Devon day also brought up the question of who is responsible for the budget and how the DWIPC can be important in this process. Suggestions were made by Michael and Katrina as to how the budget is formed. Devon also suggested that the providers do seem to bring in good results, but she also suggested that community groups and schools may be beneficial in providing suggestion for better results and investment in programming.

Billy Baldwin suggested that most providers are working, but he still feels that tavern taxi has better potential to provide faster service. He still questions the timing of picking up the inebriates. He would like to see what potential there could be to improve service.

The council also suggested that they may be able to visit other counties to see what their programming is and what they do. Michael suggested that a visit to Sandoval County in the city of Bernalillo would be a good start. He also suggested that possibly a visit from Caleb Chandler of the grant council could come by and present.

Michael also gave each council member a packet of DWIPC guidelines. It was in length and very detailed. He went through a major portion of it in his presentation.
