**1. CALL TO ORDER**

**Albuquerque Cab Co**

Mr. Hindi presented on behalf of AAC stating that the Tavern Taxi is a popular program. Tavern Taxi currently runs on Friday and Saturday nights. For the first five months of FY14, Tavern Taxi has had 34,076 pickups (from Bars) with 57,025 passengers.

Mr. Hindi stated that on Thursday nights they receive a lot of calls for Tavern Taxi since it is Lady's night at most liquor establishments and would like to discuss amending the current contract to add Thursday nights due to added business. Mr. Hindi informed the Council of the issues that his drivers have with pick-ups in the Nob Hill area which is due to no parking zones. He also notified the council that as of April 2013 a credit card machine was installed in all taxis. Tavern Taxi will run on Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.

**5. OLD BUSINESS**

**DSAP Update**

Director Katrina Hotrum informed the DWIPC that the purchase of the car wash was finalized on Tuesday, December 10, 2013. With the expanded lot DSAP wants to have a fenced in lite parking lot for staff which will free up our existing parking for visitors. Also a Portable unit is almost finished and will be used for the PIIP – Public Inebriate Intervention Program. Portable should be up and running by the beginning of the year.

Ms. Hotrum informed the DWIPC that the County Board of Commissioners have signed the terms of Board members to two (2) years but no limits.

Frank Magourilos, BC-DSAP Prevention Works Consultant spoke to the DWIPC about "Above the Influence" – which is a program where UNM athletes go to local high schools and talk to the students and give students an Above the Influence bracelet.
