**1. CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 12:28 pm by Chair Sarate.

**2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Mahe moved to approve the agenda, Scharmen seconded, motion passed.

**3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Scharmen moved that the minutes of March 2014 be approved as presented, Casias seconded. Motion passed.

#### **4. NEW BUSINESS**

##### **a. DSAP Update**

George white informed the DWIPC that DSAP is in contract negotiations with Molina regarding PIIP, Assessment Center, DSAP's Cap/outpatient program and potentially transitional living.

DSAP has been contacted by Grant County to assist in the development and implementation of a Social Model Detoxification Program. Grant County is in the process of scheduling a visit to the MATS Campus.

The Tavern Taxi Service for St. Patrick's Day and the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter totals:

- St. Patrick's day- total rides 18, total passengers 29
- Tavern Taxi for the 3rd quarter of FY14: 3,778, total passengers: 2271 rides and 29 total nights

Adolescent transitional living:

- Additional \$300k in Capital Outlay funds. In discussions with HDS on a potential pilot for transitional living.
- Went door to door in the Mead Estates to discuss the possibility of an adolescent transitional living. We are planning a formal neighborhood meeting with Commissioner De La Cruz to have further discussion.

Compliance monitoring checks:

- MADD – 3/6/2014
  - Finding #1: Lack of documentation to ensure Schools had consistent PYPM instructors. Correction: MADD will implement a process to ensure consistency.
  - Finding #2: Upon review of all of the monthly reports from MADD and discussion during the monitoring visit, it was verified that MADD has not conducted any school based prevention activities. Correction: MADD will conduct school based prevention activities per contract requirements.
- BC Detox Program – 3/13/2014
- NM State Police – 3/20/2014

##### **b. Behavior Therapy Associates**

Dr. Hester presented to the DWIPC a Project with National Institute of Alcohol abuse and Alcohol funded grant. They are completing the development of a web application for first time DWI/DUI offenders called Right Turns. The program is evidence based and the clinical trial which they are planning a soft roll out next month. The website is at [www.rightturns.com](http://www.rightturns.com)

Right Turns combines two other web applications that they already have evidence for their effectiveness: Drinkers Checkup, which is a brief motivational intervention and Overcoming Addictions, a cognitive behaviorally oriented abstinence focused web application, which in Right Turns is called the tool box. They integrated the two applications so it is easier for their clients to maneuver through them seamlessly. They've tailored this to DWI offenders by adding a screening for depression as well as assessment for recidivism risk. All information received on the clients is based on self-reporting and they emphasize that what they tell them is confidential and will not be shared with the judicial system.

**5. PUBLIC COMMENT**

Hartnett requested a closed session meeting for the DWIPC member at the next DWIPC meeting on May 8, 2014 so they can get to know one another and get a better understanding on their roles as a member. Fran recommended that DFA come to present to the DWIPC in a future meeting to help the Council with understand their role as Planning Council Members.

Laura Tomedi, PhD, MPH, NMDOH Alcohol Epidemiologist will present at the May DWIPC meeting on Alcohol and DWI statistics.
