BernCo Glyphosate Moratorium FAQs

Members of the community went to the Board of County Commissioners with concerns about the use of glyphosate. Their concerns included the dangers that glyphosate can have on both humans and the environment.

On April 23, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners approved an ordinance to permanently stop the use of glyphosate on county-owned parks and open space properties.
