A RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT A SPECIAL ELECTION BE HELD IN BERNALILLO COUNTY, NEW MEXICO AT THE NEXT REGULAR COUNTY ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE COUNTY CERTAIN QUESTIONS FOR AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS IN VARYING PRINCIPAL AMOUNTS AND FOR SPECIFIED PUBLIC PURPOSES; PROVIDING THE FORM OF THE BOND QUESTIONS; PRESCRIBING OTHER DETAILS IN CONNECTION WITH SUCH SPECIAL ELECTION AND BONDS; DIRECTING THAT A PROCLAMATION BE ISSUED CALLING THE ELECTION AS DESCRIBED HEREIN AND DIRECTING THAT THE PROCLAMATION BE PUBLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY CLERK OR A DEPUTY COUNTY CLERK TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY FOR PROPER CONDUCT OF THE ELECTION; AND RATIFYING ACTION PREVIOUSLY TAKEN IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Bernalillo County, New Mexico (the "Board"), has heretofore adopted a resolution (the "Bond Election Resolution") calling for an election upon the following questions:

1. **LIBRARY BONDS** - Shall Bernalillo County, New Mexico issue \$1,500,000 of its general obligation bonds to purchase and equip library materials and library resources for the libraries within Bernalillo County, New Mexico, said bonds to be payable from general (ad valorem) taxes to be issued and sold at such time or times, upon such terms and conditions as the Board of County Commissioners may determine as permitted by law?
2. **PUBLIC SAFETY FACILITIES AND OTHER COUNTY BUILDINGS BONDS** - Shall Bernalillo County, New Mexico, issue \$8,350,000 of its general obligation bonds to plan, design, upgrade, construct, equip and otherwise improve, and to acquire property for, County facilities, including fire station, law enforcement,

1 animal welfare and library facilities throughout the County, including necessary  
2 remodeling of facilities, construction and improvements required by the

5 and conditions as the Board of County Commissioners may determine and as  
6 permitted by law?

7 3. PARKS AND RECREATION BONDS - Shall Bernalillo County, New Mexico,  
8 issue \$5,455,000 of its general obligation bonds to plan, design, upgrade,  
9 construct, equip and otherwise improve, and to acquire property for, County park  
10 and recreational facilities, including necessary remodeling of facilities,  
11 construction and improvements required by the Americans with Disabilities Act,  
12 said bonds to be payable from general (ad valorem) taxes and to be issued and  
13 sold at such time or times, upon such terms and conditions as the Board of County  
14 Commissioners may determine and as permitted by law?

15 4. TRANSPORTATION BONDS - Shall Bernalillo County, New Mexico, issue  
16 \$12,650,000 of its general obligation bonds to plan, design, upgrade, construct,  
17 equip and otherwise improve, and to acquire property for, County roads and non-  
18 motor vehicle pathways, within the County, said bonds to be payable from general  
19 (ad valorem) taxes and to be issued and sold at such time or times, upon such  
20 terms and conditions as the Board of County Commissioners may determine and  
21 as permitted by law?

22 5. STORM DRAINAGE AND UTILITIES BONDS - Shall Bernalillo County, New  
23 Mexico, issue \$5,800,000 of its general obligation bonds to plan, design, upgrade,  
24 construct, equip and otherwise improve, and to acquire property for, necessary  
25 storm, sewer, wastewater, water and fiber optic systems within the County, said  
26 bonds to be payable from general (ad valorem) taxes and to be issued and sold at  
27 such time or times, upon such terms and conditions as the Board of County  
28 Commissioners may determine and as permitted by law?

29 6. PUBLIC HOUSING BONDS - Shall Bernalillo County, New Mexico, issue  
30 \$2,500,000 of its general obligation bonds to plan, design, upgrade, construct,  
31 rehabilitate, equip and otherwise improve, and to acquire property for, County-

1 owned affordable housing for low-income families and disabled or indigent  
2 individuals, including necessary remodeling of facilities, construction and  
3 improvements required by the Americans with Disabilities Act, said bonds to be  
4 payable from general (ad valorem) taxes and to be issued and sold at such time or  
5 times, upon such terms and conditions as the Board of County Commissioners  
6 may determine and as permitted by law?

7 **WHEREAS**, the Bond Election Resolution was duly adopted and is in  
8 accordance with law.

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY**  
10 **COMMISSIONERS OF BERNALILLO COUNTY, NEW MEXICO:**

11 **SECTION 1.** The special bond election (the "Election") called for by the Bond  
12 Election Resolution shall be held in Bernalillo County, New Mexico, shall be held on the  
13 8th day of November, 2016 (the "Election Date") which is the same date as the statewide  
14 general election.

15 **SECTION 2.** The Proclamation and Notice authorized herein, in substantially  
16 the following form with only such changes as are approved by the Chair or Vice-Chair of  
17 the Board and as provided by law, shall constitute a public proclamation calling the  
18 Election on the date set forth above and setting forth certain other details of the Election  
19 as required by § 1-24-2(A), NMSA 1978, as amended, and upon passage and approval  
20 shall be filed forthwith with the County Clerk of the County, and in accordance with the  
21 provisions of § 1-24-2(B), NMSA 1978, as amended, shall be published in full, in  
22 English and Spanish, once a week for at least two (2) consecutive weeks, commencing  
23 not less than fifty-six days before the Election Date, and the County Clerk shall obtain  
24 affidavits of publication thereof and shall file the same with the minutes of this meeting:

12 6. PUBLIC HOUSING BONDS - Shall Bernalillo County, New Mexico, issue  
13 \$2,500,000 of its general obligation bonds to plan, design, upgrade, construct,  
14 rehabilitate, equip and otherwise improve, and to acquire property for, County-  
15 owned affordable housing for low-income families and disabled or indigent  
16 individuals, including necessary remodeling of facilities, construction and  
17 improvements required by the Americans with Disabilities Act, said bonds to be  
18 payable from general (ad valorem) taxes and to be issued and sold at such time or  
19 times, upon such terms and conditions as the Board of County Commissioners  
20 may determine and as permitted by law?

21 The Bonds shall have a net effective interest rate of not more than ten percent  
22 (10%) a year, unless the State Board of Finance at any time prior to delivery of the bonds  
23 approves a higher net effective interest rate in writing, and the bonds shall mature not  
24 more than 20 years from their date.

25 No ballot on the bond election shall be received unless, on the date of the election,  
26 the person offering to vote is a registered, qualified elector of the County. The  
27 registration books of Bernalillo County shall be closed by the County Clerk at 5:00 p.m.  
28 on Tuesday, October 11, 2016. Any person otherwise eligible to vote as a qualified  
29 elector and not currently registered may register prior to such time at the Office of the  
30 County Clerk, One Civic Plaza NW, 6th Floor, Albuquerque, New Mexico, or at the  
31 office of any National Voter Registration Act (NVRA) agency.
