- **Possible newspaper feature**

Information / Criteria

1. Nominations for the South Valley Pride Day 2016 Outstanding Citizen Awards will be accepted through **Monday, March 14, 2016**
2. A nomination form, together with a one or two page biography describing the deserving nominee must be submitted to Mountain View Community Center, 201 Prosperity SE, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87105 or via email to bmartinez@bernco.gov.
3. Possible Outstanding Citizen Candidates may be a South Valley resident with involvement in school or community groups, church groups, student government, honor roll, a longtime community resident, business owners, ministers, volunteers, teachers, coaches, etc.

The committee will meet on Tuesday, March 15 to review nominations and score each nomination with ratings ranging from 1-5 (1 being the low rating and 5 being the highest). A cumulative score sheet together with committee dialogue will determine the South Valley Celebration 2016 Outstanding Citizen Award winners. Winners will be contacted with further South Valley Celebration 2016 event instructions. Our award winners will also be scheduled to take their picture, which will be featured on the South Valley Celebration 2016 poster and have the opportunity to go over their biography with the committee representative.
