Richard Garcia is an independent genealogical and historical researcher. His knowledge of migrations, history and genealogy of Isleta is unmatched. Garcia will present the blending of pueblo and non-pueblo tribes from early contact with Europeans through the present day, and the resulting influences on Isleta cultural identity and traditional values. Special focus will be on the 19th century Laguna migration.
