WHO CAN APPLY?

- Must be a registered voter in Bernalillo County
- Cannot be a candidate or related to any candidate currently on the ballot
- Cannot be employed by law enforcement
- Must be mentally and physically able to perform the assigned duties

PROGRAM BENEFITS

- Put your patriotism into action and serve your community in an important position of trust
- Meet and work with interesting people in your community
- Break out of the everyday routine, and
- Earn a little extra cash!

RESPONSIBILITIES

- **Election Day:** Poll Officials report to duty at 6 a.m. and work until all duties are performed.
- **Early Voting:** Officials work three to four weeks before Election Day. Shifts are: M/W/F or T/Th/Sa, from 7:30 a.m. to closing. Individuals assigned to Early Voting must work on Election Day

Responsibilities vary depending on the assigned position and on the job training opportunities are available.

TRAINING & COMPENSATION

Poll Officials must attend training prior to working the election. Training helps ensure a thorough understand of the election process, maintaining the integrity of the election, and respective roles as a poll official.
