## Student Election Clerks needed for Upcoming Elections!

### WHO CAN APPLY?

- Must be a U.S. Citizen and at least 16 years old
- Must have written permission from parent(s) or legal guardian, unless emancipated.
- Cannot be related to any candidate currently on the ballot
- The student's parent or legal guardian must reside in Bernalillo County.



### PROGRAM BENEFITS

- Gain real-life work experience (which may apply for a special project in government or civics classes, or on college admission applications).
- Fulfill an important civic duty.
- Meet and work with interesting people in your community.
- Break out of the classroom routine, and
- Earn a little extra cash! Student Election Clerks are paid \$150 for working Election Day.

- Assist with the opening and closing of the polling place
- Check in voters
- Help ensure a fair and accurate election
