TITLE: Presentation of a Proclamation in recognition of the 40th Anniversary of the Escabosa, New Mexico Riders Club

ACTION: The Escabosa, New Mexico Riders Club celebrates its 40th anniversary this month in the small Bernalillo County ranching community bearing the same name along N.M. State Road 337 half way between Miera and Chilili. The club was formed by three, longtime Escabosa ranchers: Andres Mora and two cousins: Julian and Cosme Pahi, with the intent to sponsor annual, fun filled, family-oriented rodeos and to promote horseback riding—a healthy, relaxing outdoor activity. The club has now grown to include to some 30 adult members, many of whom in the early 1970s pitched in and built a huge outdoors arena complete with bucking chutes and livestock pens at which they sponsor their rodeos. The Board offers congratulations to the members of the club for their dedication in making this organization a cornerstone of the community.
