The officers walked through a scenario for the committee. APD is in process of training new MCT clinician, trained 4 back up APD officers, did a video for BHI lately. APD MCT clinician provided a scenario walk through for the committee from a clinical side. They also follow up with the clients and getting good feedback from family and the clients. In the future, once the service expansion is ready it will be a referral source, and MCT teams will be able to bring clients as appropriate
- f. Monday meeting- special meeting called by the county commission for the Behavioral Health as a whole in conference room B on the 10th floor
