  - iii. Community Supports- Crossroads for Women Peer Case Management contract was executed and program development is underway.
  - iv. Steering Committee- Kathy reported that there is discussion to put funds towards behavioral health services at two elementary school health centers—Los Padillas and Emerson and a program to focus on housing services for sex-trafficked youth.
