



## RESIDENTIAL WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES FORM For New Construction and Remodel/Additions

The Bernalillo County Water Conservation Ordinance (Section 30-241 through 30-251 of the Bernalillo County Code) requires all new residential construction in the unincorporated area of Bernalillo County to implement one of the three water conservation alternatives below. All residential remodels or additions within the unincorporated area must use EPA WaterSense-labeled fixtures (i.e. 1.28 gpf toilets, 2.0 gpm showerheads, and 1.5 gpm lavatory faucets/aerators) for any new plumbing fixtures installed. The County will conduct an inspection to verify these water conservation requirements have been met prior to issuance of the Certificate of Occupancy. Applicants who wish to utilize Alternative 1 or 2 below, or claim an exemption to the Water Conservation Ordinance must contact the Water Conservation Program at (505) 848-1500 for further instructions.

*Use of high water use plants and high water use turf, combined, shall not exceed the lesser of 1,500 square feet or 10% of landscape area.  
If 10% of landscaped area is less than 300 square feet, high water use plants and high water use turf, combined, may total up to 300 square feet.  
The list of low, medium, high use plants maintained by ABCWUA will be the plant list used for determination of plant water use category  
Ornamental ponds shall not exceed 500 square feet, ornamental fountains shall not be designed and constructed to exceed 250 square feet*
