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**1. CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 12:35 pm by Chair Sarate.

**2. APPROVAL OF AGENDA**

Hartnett moved to approve the agenda, Mahe seconded, motion passed.

**3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Mahe moved that the minutes of April 2014 be approved as presented, Casias seconded. Motion passed.

#### 4. **NEW BUSINESS**

##### a. **DSAP Update**

George white informed the DWIPC that DSAP is in contract negotiations with Molina regarding PIIP, Assessment Center, DSAP's Cap/outpatient program and potentially transitional living.

Chance's birthday party has been scheduled for June 11, 2014; invitations to come.

The Tavern Taxi Service for Cinco de Mayo totals:

- Pick Me Up/Take Me Out - total rides 11, total passengers 19
- Tavern Taxi – total rides 49, total passengers: 79

Adolescent transitional living:

- Additional \$300k in Capital Outlay funds. In discussions with HDS on a potential pilot for transitional living.
- Formal neighborhood meeting with Commissioner De la Cruz in regards to the Hogares property has been scheduled for May 12th, 2014.

Compliance monitoring checks:

- Bernalillo County Sheriff
  - Finding #1: The third quarter deposition report was not submitted by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month following the end of the third quarter. Response required by May 16, 2014.

##### b. **Behavior Therapy Associates**

Dr. Troy Rodgers presented the All Stars Update: The 2013-2014 school year was the 7<sup>th</sup> year FBHA has implemented the All Stars Program in Bernalillo County middle schools. During this seven year timeframe they have seen over 5060 students complete the program in over 12 different middle schools. In 2013-2014 the number of schools allowing FBHA to provide the All Star Program to students was 9. The number of students who completed the All Stars Program in the 2013-2014 school year was 760. The average number of classes going on during any given semester over the seven year period is 23.

All Stars Impact – The general consensus is that the All Stars Program has been an effective prevention tool for youth in our community. It has also been described as an avenue for children to obtain direction and much needed support. FBHA has become a staple in many of the schools we service and consequently FBHA staff are routinely approached for help by students in class.

Current schools: McKinley Middle School, Cleveland Middle School, Garfield Middle School, Taylor Middle School, La Resolana Leadership Academy, San Felipe Middle School, Grant (YMCA Program) Immanuel Lutheran Middle School and Jimmy Carter Middle School.

**c. New Mexico Department of Health – Epidemiology and Response Division**

Laura Tomedi – Alcohol Epidemiologist presented to the council DWI data. Laura is one of two Epidemiologists in the Nation one here in New Mexico and the other in Michigan. The reason one is New Mexico is because New Mexico leads the nation in alcohol related deaths since 1997. In 2012 nearly 1200 New Mexican died from alcohol related causes. NM is one of the highest per capita costs of excessive alcohol use in the Nation. Last time it was calculated was in 2006 and they are currently working on their next paper which is 2010. Some Bernalillo County specific information they look at is risk and burden. Bernalillo County is what they call high burden. A large part of NM population is in Bernalillo County so when Bernalillo County is compared to the State rate and Bernalillo County almost exactly the same. When looking at Bernalillo County they always for all outcomes has the highest burden. Bernalillo County and New Mexico are pretty similar for alcohol related deaths, alcohol chronic disease.
