

Report Highlights


- The MDC on-site population decreased during July 2019, from 1,614 on July 1st to 1,432 (an 11.3% decrease) on July 31st.
- Bookings decreased 1.6% from 2,358 in June 2019 to 2,320 in July 2019.

- The MDC population began increasing in late 2017. It has continued to increase during May 2019. The on-site population at the beginning of July 2019 was 1,614 and decreased 11.3% from the beginning of the month down to 1,432 by the end of the month. The population during 2019 increased by 8.3% from 1,323 on January 1, 2019 to the end of July 2019.
- The use of the Community Custody Program (CCP) decreased during July 2019 from 85 at the start of the month to 77 at the end of the month.




BOOKINGS, RELEASES, AND LENGTH OF STAY

- Jail population is affected by two factors: how many people are booked and how long they stay.
- Bookings decreased 1.6% from 2,358 in June 2019 to 2,320 in July 2019. Releases increased to a greater degree, increasing 8.9% from June 2019 to July 2019.
- The number of bookings and releases were higher in July 2019 than in July 2018. There were 14.2% (288) more bookings in 2019 and 17.5% (372) more releases.



- The LOS for July 2019 was 25.8 days, 3.9 days higher than the LOS of 21.9 days in July 2018, an increase of 17.8%. The LOS increased 6.9 days (26.7%) from June 2019 to July 2019.
