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

Report Highlights


- The total MDC population increased from 1,279 at the end of March of 2018 to 1,393 at the end of April of 2018.
- The MDC population has been at or below the 1,950 cap for 1,266 days, over 3 years.

- Jail population is a result of two factors: how many people are booked and how long they stay.
- Bookings decreased annually from 2009 through 2015 followed by a slight increase in 2016 and a slight decrease in 2017. Bookings for the first four months of 2018 (9,021) are higher than the first quarter of 2016 (8,449) and 2017 (8,288).




- Population reduction initiatives have helped to reduced the length of stay which, combined with reduced bookings, decreased the jail population.
- The MDC population increased slightly during the first four months of 2018.

Bookings, Releases, and Length of Stay



- Until a slight increase in 2016, annual bookings have decreased since 2009.
- Bookings and releases increased during the four months of 2018. Bookings were 8.8% higher in this time period in 2018 than 2017 and releases were 9.4% higher during this time period than 2017.



- The LOS for April of 2018 was 18.5 days, slightly lower than the LOS of 18.7 days in April of 2017.
- Criminal justice initiatives have reduced the LOS, improved efficiency, and increased the rate at which inmates turnover at the jail.

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
