12. Anyone inside at the time of the fire. If yes, how many	Family of 6 inside at the time of the fire – everyone made it out on their own
13. How was family alerted? (smoke detector, neighbors)	Smell of smoke in the building
14. Injuries? If yes, include age, gender, transport info & injuries sustained.	Minor smoke inhalation to one family member – 24 y.o. female. No one transported
15. Fire Origin? Was it contained to origin?	Fire was contained to an approx. 25 ft area of the roof
16. Spread through %	10% of the roof – no fire damage inside the rest of the structure
17. Smoke Damage (light or heavy smoke damage throughout)	Very light smoke damage in the room just below the fire, moderate water damage in the room below
18. Cause (determined/undetermined -->accident,natural,incendiary)	Accidental - Fire earlier in the day in the furnace for which they did not call 911 for. Believed residual heat from the first fire caused the second
19. Estimated Damages (structural, contents/vehicle)	\$5000-8000 – structural
20. Assisting Agencies like Red Cross, # of displaced?	Red Cross was notified and was responding for the family of 6
21. Contributing factors such as wind or location	None
22. Additional information (rescues, FF injuries and so on)	No FF injuries noted
23. On Scene POC	Richard Price – 505-417-2697 – (property resident)
24. Community Risk Reduction Message	Clean furnace filters and proper maintenance, call 911 for all fires in a home and let fire department investigate. Install smoke detectors in all residences to have early notification of fires within a residence.
25. Additional Information	Residents had a fire at the house earlier that day (did not call 911 for that fire).
