Atrisco Vista Boulevard Corridor Study Public Open House Scheduled TODAY

BernCo Public Works Division invites the community to an open house to discuss the Atrisco Vista Boulevard Corridor Study. The Atrisco Vista Boulevard Corridor project is a planning, engineering, and environmental study to examine potential routes to extend Atrisco Vista Boulevard north to Southern Boulevard in Sandoval County. The public open house will be held, **Wednesday, Dec. 5 beginning at 6 p.m. at the Paradise Hills Community Center, 5901 Paradise Blvd. NW.**

The study will evaluate:

- **Enhancing** the existing Atrisco Vista Boulevard roadway through shoulder-widening and safety improvements from Double Eagle II Road north to Paseo del Norte Boulevard.
- **Extending** Atrisco Vista Boulevard to create a new roadway connection from Paseo del Norte Boulevard to Southern Boulevard.
- **Adding** a multi-use trail for pedestrian and bikes throughout the entire project area

Cold Weather Safety Tips for Pets

It's a common misconception that dogs and cats won't get cold because of their fur. If your pets have to be outside, here are some outside housing tips for your pets:

- Do not use fabric blankets or bedding. Once wet, they ice over when temperatures drop, and become wet again with your animal's body heat.
- Place the shelter's entrance facing south to southeast to maximize exposure to the sun.
- If the opening is uncovered, consider attaching a thick piece of rubber, doormat or carpet scrap cut to size to block the wind, rain and snow.
- Make sure the shelter is as airtight as possible.
- Check the water bowl frequently for freezing.

Remember, if it's too cold for you, it's probably too cold for your pet, so keep your animals inside. If left outdoors, pets can freeze, become disoriented, lost, stolen, injured or killed. In addition, don't leave pets alone in a car during cold weather, as cars can act as refrigerators that hold in the cold and cause animals to freeze to death.
