These fireworks are permissible for sale or use in the unincorporated areas of Bernalillo County.

Ground and hand-held sparkling devices:

- Cone fountains
- Crackling devices
- Cylindrical fountains
- Flitter sparklers
- Ground spinners
- Illuminating torches
- Wheels

The following fireworks are **NOT** permissible for sale or use in the unincorporated areas of BernCo.

Aerial devices:

- Aerial shell kit-reloadable tubes
- Aerial spinners
- Helicopters
- Mines
- Missile-type rockets
- Multiple tube devices
- Roman candles
- Shells
- Stick-type rockets

Ground audible devices:

- Chasers
- Firecrackers
