Please come any time between 6:30pm to 8:00pm to learn more about the project and provide comments on the recommended alternative.

Please join the Bernalillo County Public Works Division in an open house meeting to discuss proposed improvements to Atrisco Vista Boulevard. The purpose of the open house is to provide the public an opportunity to learn about project recommendations and for the County to obtain public input and comments.

This project is an engineering and environmental study of a potential new roadway. The study has evaluated:

-  Enhancing the existing Atrisco Vista Boulevard roadway through shoulder-widening and safety improvements from Double Eagle II Road north to Paseo del Norte
-  Extending Atrisco Vista Boulevard to create a new roadway connection from Paseo del Norte to Southern Boulevard
-  Adding a multi-use trail for pedestrian and bikes throughout the entire new project area
-  Improving Southern Boulevard to accommodate added traffic from the connection to Atrisco Vista Blvd



What are the objectives of the Atrisco Vista Boulevard study?

-  Provide better connections of the major roadways that serve southern Rio Rancho and northwest Albuquerque
-  Improve access to developing areas and planned development in northwest Albuquerque and southwest Rio Rancho
-  Encourage development of major employment centers on Albuquerque's westside to increase employment opportunities
-  Improve safety along the existing section of roadway

This study has evaluated alternatives and proposed a recommended alternative. The open house will provide a project overview, summarize work that has been done to date, and describe the recommended alternative and next steps.


