
A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL LEGISLATIVE POLICY FOR THE COUNTY OF BERNALILLO FOR THE FIFTY FIRST LEGISLATURE, FIRST SESSION, OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO.

1. Support legislation and capital outlay requests that promote the sustainability and profitability of small-scale, local agriculture in Bernalillo County.
2. Support pension reform that gives all public safety—police, fire, corrections, and juvenile corrections alike—the same retirement benefits. Bernalillo County supports any attempts to exempt any one of several of these groups or to create special treatment and a separate tier for any one or several of these groups without including the others.






