ORDER ON COMPLAINANT'S MOTION TO CONTINUE EVIDENTIARY HEARING

THIS MATTER came before the Bernalillo County Code of Conduct Review Board (BCCCRB) on Thursday, March 22, 2018. After careful review of the Complainant's Motion To Continue Evidentiary Hearing, and hearing both parties, W. Dennis Maez, Complainant, and Commissioner Wayne Johnson, Respondent's arguments, the BCCCRB ORDERS as follows:

The Bernalillo County Code of Conduct Review Board unanimously voted to grant the Complainant's Motion to Continue the Evidentiary Hearing, and that the Acting Chair be given authority to issue an Order from the Board with instructions to the parties as follows:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. The Board has decided to continue the Evidentiary Hearing to a date to be set after April 2, 2018.
2. The Board has met the requirement of taking action within ninety (90) days of the Sworn Complaint, and the Board finds good cause to extend any applicable time limits to convene the Hearing.
3. The parties shall meet and confer with regards to scheduling the Evidentiary Hearing, determining the availability of the attorneys and necessary witnesses by April 2, 2018. The parties shall also confer about the scope and breadth of any subpoenas planned to be issued for production of documents, and attempt to come to an agreement. The Board expects the parties to submit dates of availability for the Evidentiary Hearing by April 2, 2018.

4. The date of the Evidentiary Hearing will be set after April 2, 2018.
