

Peer Support Drop-in Centers

Peer support drop-in centers serve community members living with mental health and/or co-occurring substance use disorders. Peers, who have lived experience, provide recovery services and create an environment where members have a robust opportunity to connect to services, reduce harm to themselves and engage in healthy life-changing recovery efforts.

- Bernalillo County Funding: \$300,000 annually recurring.
- Implemented in September 2018, year two of the projects are underway.
- Contracted services with two providers: Albuquerque Center for Hope and Recovery (ACHR) provides adult services at the Unser and Central Library and 4th street main offices. In addition, they offer the Addicts 2 Athletes substance abuse program at the Westside Community Center in the South Valley. New Day’s Youth BLAST (“Building Lives around Self Truth”) Peer Support Drop-in Center for young people (16-22 years old) and provides behavioral health resources from community partners. The drop-in center is located at Johnny Tapia Community Center at Wells Park.
