


# ESSENTIAL BUSINESSES CHECKLIST

## PUBLIC HEALTH ORDER EFFECTIVE APRIL 7, 2020



### ALL ESSENTIAL BUSINESSES MUST:

- ✓ Minimize operations and staff as much as possible
- ✓ Ensure that patrons and staff are staying 6ft apart. This includes patrons waiting outside of the facility to enter.
- ✓ Limit their total occupancy:
  - ✓ Allow no more than 20% of their maximum occupancy to be in their store at any given time
  - ✓ Allow no more employees than the maximum number of customers plus 50
- ✓ Avoid person-to-person contact
- ✓ Employees must wash hands frequently
- ✓ Surfaces must be cleaned routinely
- ✓ Limit the sales of medications, durable medical equipment, baby formula, diapers, sanitary care products, and hygiene products to three of each item per individual



**Ensure that patrons and staff are staying 6ft apart**



**Allow no more than 20% of their maximum occupancy**




**Employees must wash hands frequently**

### HOTELS, MOTELS, RV PARKS, AND OTHER PLACES OF LODGING MUST ALSO FOLLOW THE ABOVE SOCIAL DISTANCING GUIDELINES, AND:

- ✓ Allow no more than 25% of their maximum occupancy to reside in their facility
- ✓ Health care workers or other individuals under the care of NM Department of Health using these facilities for extended stays, temporary housing, or for quarantine or isolation are exempt from counting towards the total occupancy.
