## Your Good Work




Poll officials did a great job in the following areas:

**Provisional Ballot Procedures:** For the second time in the 2018 election cycle, NO provisional ballots were inserted into tabulators. This is a tremendous accomplishment.

**Hand Tally Procedures:** All hand tally ballots were placed in lime-green hand tally envelopes. We did not need a judge's order to access ballot boxes in search of hand tally ballots.

**Pink Application/Permit Procedures:** All pink applications/permits were found by our canvassing board in the bankers' boxes. Again, no judge's order was needed to access ballot boxes to retrieve pink applications and/or permits.

## What Happened in the 2018 General Election



**Total # Poll Officials Trained:** 734

**Total # Absentee Ballots Received:** 23,817

**Total # of Voters Who Cast Ballots:** 241,752

**Busiest Sites (Early Voting):** Caracol Plaza (16,985); Petroglyph Plaza (16,372); Daskalos Center (15,257); Holly Plaza (14,064).

**Busiest Sites (Election Day):** 98th and Central Shopping Center (2,770); Petroglyph Plaza (2,459); Daskalos Center (2,172); UNM (1,960).

## Video Training



In reviewing poll official responses to video training quizzes, these are the questions that had the most incorrect answers:

**Why is electioneering not allowed in or near polling locations?**

(478 got this wrong. The answer: It removes the neutrality of a polling location.)

**Watchers are designated by election-related organizations or group of \_\_\_ candidates.** (376 got this wrong. The answer: Three.)

**True or False. Bernalillo County polling locations are set up in a circular motion.** (237 got this wrong. Answer: True.)

**And the question that had the fewest number of people answer incorrectly (Only 4 of 566 got this wrong!):**

**True or False. Poll officials should not move any signage that already has been placed by Clerk's staff in and around the polling location.** (Answer: True.)
