What's on the Ballot?



This is another big election year for New Mexico. The federal and statewide offices that are on the ballot this year: U.S. Senator (one position), U.S. House of Representatives (three positions), governor, lieutenant governor, secretary of state, state auditor, state treasurer, commissioner of public lands (one position), attorney general, and judges of the court of appeals (five positions), all 70 positions in the state House of Representatives, Public Regulation Commission (three positions), public education commission (six positions).

County races on the ballot are county commissioners (Districts 1 and 5), county assessor, county sheriff, and probate judge.

Put these important dates on your calendar:

Now through March 15: Update your [Shiftboard](#) profile so we can start making assignments and be ready for April 11, which is our deadline to publicize poll official assignments for Early Voting and Election Day.

April 11—15: You will receive your assignment for Early Voting and/or Election Day. You must accept your assignment within 2 weeks.

April 23: Poll officials who work at Clerk's Annex and during Early Voting will be able to sign up for in-person training on Shiftboard.

April 25: Deadline to accept your Early Voting and/or Election Day assignment in Shiftboard.

April 28: In-person training begins at BOE Warehouse for poll officials who work at Clerk's Annex and during Early Voting.

May 7: Election Day poll officials will begin signing up for in-person training.

May 8: Clerk's Annex opens (Absentee ballot location).

May 19: Early Voting begins. Early Voting will take place at 19 locations open Monday through Saturday from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

May 19: Election Day in-person training begins.

June 2: Early Voting ends.

June 5: Primary Election Day.

What's New In Training
