**NO CELL PHONES OR PURSES IN VISITING ROOM NO TOBACCO PRODUCTS OR LIGHTERS**

Inmates are allowed two visits per week; and must have been in custody for 72 hours before visits can begin.

**Visits may be denied for any of the following reasons:**

- An MDC supervisor, manager, or administrator considers the visitor a threat to the safety of the center, staff, the public, or inmates
- The inmate refuses the visit
- The visitor is abusive verbally, physically, or otherwise, to MDC personnel
- The visitor is not present at the time the visit is called
- The visitor is inappropriately dressed
- Must not have been incarcerated in the facility within the past 90 days
- Children must be supervised at all times. After a verbal warning, the Visitor will be asked, by security staff to leave the premises, and the visit cancelled for the day.

**Visitor Dress Code (appropriate dress for male and female visitors, 12 years of age and older)**

- Revealing, sheer, or see-through clothing is not allowed
- Shorts or miniskirts are not allowed (Shorts below the knee are acceptable)
- Sleeveless or low-cut shirts are not allowed
- Dresses and Capri pants must be below the knee when in a seated position
- Some type of footwear must be worn by the visitor at all times (sandals and flip-flops are acceptable)
- Hats, bandanas, and scarves are not allowed
- Car seats, strollers, and diaper bags are not permitted in the visiting room, but can be left in the designated area in the lobby
- Coats must be removed prior to visit and can be placed in available lockers or in the designated area
- Only three (3) people per visit (regardless of age)
