North Valley Sewer Improvements

\$3,100,000 is requested to fund this project which includes the right-of-way acquisition, sewer assessment, design and ultimate construction of a sewer system servicing a neighborhood in the North Valley of Albuquerque, NM. The project is bounded by Roy Avenue on the south, the New Mexico Department of Transportation Railroad on the west, the Sandia Pueblo to the north and Edith Blvd. to the east. This project is intended to protect and enhance groundwater quality in the region through the ultimate decommissioning of private residential sewer septic systems in the neighborhood. The project will also enhance existing residential roads, improving access and the long term operations and maintenance cost for these facilities.

Right-of-way acquisition estimated to cost approximately \$100,000. While, construction activities are currently estimated to cost approximately \$3,000,000. Bernalillo County is funding the analysis and design of the sewer system using existing county water and wastewater bond funds.
